This petition has been filed seeking direction to the respondent to release the petitioner on parole in terms of Section 3(1) (b) of Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1988, to enable him to attend the marriage of his real sister scheduled for 23.02.2019.

Petitioner is confined in District Jail, Rohtak, after he was convicted in case FIR No.458 dated 22.08.2013, under Sections 302, 120B, 307, 506 IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station, Central Faridabad. He has been sentenced to undergo imprisonment for life.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that on previous occasions he has been released on parole and after parole he has surrendered within the specified time. There is no complaint against the petitioner of misuse of parole.

He states that on 21.01.2019 petitioner had gone to submit application before respondent No.3 requesting for release on parole to attend the marriage of his real sister. However, the same was not accepted by the respondent stating that it could not be processed within a short period.

In pursuance of notice of motion reply has been filed on behalf of the respondent-State, wherein it has been verified that the marriage of the sister of the petitioner is fixed for 23.02.2019. It has however been stated that the petitioner has not submitted any application for parole.

In view of the above, this petition is disposed of by directing the petitioner to submit an application to respondent No.3 seeking release on parole within two days. The respondents are requested to process the said application and pass a final order thereupon urgently preferably before 20.02.2019 and keeping in view that the petitioner has earlier been released on parole and surrendered in time and there is no complaint against his misuse of the parole.

A copy of this order be given dasti to learned State counsel under signatures of the Bench Secretary of this Court.
