The grievance of the petitioners is that though there is no case registered against the petitioners, they have been repeatedly called to the Police Station and threatened by respondent No.3 at the instance of private respondents No.5 to 7. The petitioners have mentioned specific dates on which they have been called to the Police Station. It is alleged that they have even been forced to sign on blank paper.

Learned counsel contends that if the petitioners are required for the purpose of investigation, the procedure as contemplated under Section 160 Cr.P.C. is to be followed.

Without going into the merits of the case, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 that if the petitioners are required for investigation in connection with any case, the procedure as contemplated under Section 160 Cr.P.C. be strictly followed.
