Learned counsel for the petitioner states that for the release of the provident fund, the petitioner had approached this Court by filing CWP No.21929 of 2018. The said writ petition was disposed of by this Court on 31.08.2018 directing the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 21.05.2018 served by the petitioner. Counsel for the petitioner states that while deciding the said legal notice, the Assistant Provident Fund Commissioner has not taken into account actual amount which the Haryana Housing Board deposited with the Provident Fund Commissioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further states that as per letter dated 26.11.2018, Haryana Housing Board informed the Assistant Provident Fund Commissioner that a sum of Rs.79,572/- was deposited whereas while deciding the case, the Assistant Provident Fund Commissioner noticed that only a sum of Rs.37,556/- was available with them as deposited by the Haryana Housing Board.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the said discrepancy has already been brought to the notice of the Regional Provident Fund Commissioner by the petitioner by filing a representation dated 14.11.2018, but reply has been received so far.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further states that the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents authorities i.e. the Provident Fund Commissioner to decide the representation dated 14.11.2018 (Annexure P-12) by passing appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by him in the representation dated 14.11.2018 (Annexure P-12), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the representation dated 14.11.2018 (Annexure P-12) within a period of three months from the receipt of certified copy of this order.
