MANOJ BAJAJ, J.

By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioners have sought anticipatory bail in FIR No.333 dated 25.12.2018 registered under Sections 22 of the NDPS Act registered at Police Station Sadar Jagaron, District Ludhiana.

On 04.02.2019 this Court had passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that upon a secret information received by the police, recovery of 200 grams of heroin was effected from Mangat Singh, who was seen coming on foot. Though the names of the petitioners are mentioned in the alleged secret information received by the police, however, at the time of recovery none of the petitioner was present. It is further pointed out that co-accused Gurmit Kumar @ Deputy has already been granted the concession of interim bail.

Notice of motion for 20.03.2019.

In the meanwhile, petitioner shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, he shall be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that in pursuance of the order dated 04.02.2019, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI-Tej Singh submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation and they are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 04.02.2019, is made absolute.
