The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.0002 dated 04.01.2019 registered under Section 420 IPC at Police Station Jhunir, District, Mansa, Punjab.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the case against the petitioner was a result of the misunderstanding. The petitioner acted only as a mediator. Ultimately, after the misunderstanding is removed between the parties, even the complainant has settled the matter with the petitioner.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Rajat Bansal, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State. Mr. J.S. Khiva, Advocate appears for the complainant. Learned counsel for the complainant does not dispute the fact that the parties have since settled the matter. The complainant has no grievance against the present petitioner.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed. Let the petitioner be released on anticipatory bail subject to his furnishing personal

bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer.

However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when and if called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
