It is contended that the petitioner is the allottee of surplus land and has been in possession thereof since the year 1974. Civil litigation is pending between the parties and the High Court has granted a stay order in favour of the petitioner. The private respondents have meanwhile trespassed into the property of the petitioner and despite representation dated 16.12.2018 (Annexure P3) having been submitted, but the police has failed to take any action. Copies of the said representation have also been given to respondents No.2 and 3.
