This is a petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus for releasing detainee Antim @ Tannu from the illegal detention of respondent Nos.4 and 5.

Notice of motion was issued. Respondent No.3-SHO was directed to visit the house of private respondent Nos.4 and 5 and make enquiry as to whether detainee- Antim @ Tannu is residing there with her own consent or has been detained by the private respondents illegally and forcibly. He was also directed to submit his report in this regard.

Report by way of affidavit of Harinder Singh Bhatti Inspector No.314/FDK, SHO, Police Station Moti Nagar, Ludhiana on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3 has been filed. Same is taken on record.

There is a mention regarding recording the statement of detainee Antim @ Tannu by the police in which she states that she is residing with her parents as per her own consent.

In view of the report submitted by learned State counsel, learned counsel for the petitioner wants to withdraw the instant petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
