In the present writ petition, the grievance which has been raised by the petitioner is that the petitioner had worked on daily wage basis from 15.12.1979 till 26.07.1990 but the said period has not been taken into account as a qualifying service for calculating the pensionary benefits.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further states that for the relief which has been claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioner has served the respondents with a legal notice dated 10.09.2018 (Annexure P-5) and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 10.09.2018 (Annexure P-5) by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by him in the legal notice dated 10.09.2018 (Annexure P-5), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 10.09.2018 (Annexure P-5) within a period of three months from the receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case, it is found that the petitioner is entitled to any monetary benefits after the decision of the legal notice, the same should also be paid to him within three months thereafter.
