AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

These two contempt petitions have been filed pleading wilful disobedience of orders dated 30.07.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No.13665 of 2016 and No.13617 of 2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that directions of this Court with regard to regularization have been complied with and

monetary benefits have been released only to petitioner No.2 (in COCP No.444 of 2019) i.e. Ram Kanwar but benefits with regard to petitioner No.1 in COCP No.444 of 2019 and both the petitioners in COCP No.1192 of 2019 have not been granted.

Learned State counsel on instructions from Mr. Rupesh Chander, Executive Engineer, Public Health, Bhiwani, submits that monetary benefits of the petitioners concerned shall be released within six weeks from today.

In view of statement made, both the contempt petitions are disposed of.

However, it is made clear that if the statement made today in the Court is not adhered to, petitioners would be at liberty to revive the contempt petition.
