The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case registered vide FIR No.87 dated 8.6.2018 under Sections 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, Police Station Dharamkot, District Moga.

One of the ground raised in the application is that the wife of the petitioner is in family way and there is none-else to look after her. The petition is accompanied by medical certificate in respect of the pregnancy of the petitioner's wife. A perusal of the said certificates shows that the expected date of delivery is 27.06.2019.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is dismissed at this stage with a liberty to the petitioner to file afresh on medical grounds at a later stage i.e. nearer the time of expected date of delivery.
