This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.34 dated 18.04.2018 registered under Sections 22/61 of NDPS Act, 1985 at Police Station Kotbhai, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has been in custody since 18.04.2018.

Custody certificate by way of affidavit of Shivraj Singh Nandgarh, Superintendent District Jail, Sri Muktsar Sahib on behalf of State has been filed and the same is taken on record.

Learned Deputy Advocate General on instructions from SI Ram Singh states that out of 10 witnesses, 01 witness has been examined and the case is now fixed for 13.02.2019 and instead of releasing the

petitioner on bail, it would be appropriate to put a time cap on the trial and in case the accused does not obstruct the trial the prosecution will lead its entire evidence on or before 05.04.2019 and till such time the bail should not be granted to the petitioner.

I find this to be a fair submission. In the circumstances, in view of the undertaking given by the learned Deputy Advocate General, it is directed that in case the prosecution does not lead its entire evidence on or before 05.04.2019 (subject to the accused not obstructing the same) the petitioner be released on bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
