HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

The petitioner had filed an application to the Halqa Kanungo for demarcation and measurement of passage/rasta on 18.03.2013, but, no action was taken thereon. He then moved a representation dated 17.07.2017 (Annexure P-1) to respondent No.3-Sub Divisional Magistrate Talwandi Sabo, District Bathinda, who got demarcation conducted. Private respondents No.6 to 8 were found to be in illegal possession of the Khasra No.1037/2. However, they have not vacated the passage/rasta and even the the points marked by the Kanungo at the time of demarcation, have been demolished by them. The petitioner is pursuing his remedies with regard to illegal possession by the respondents. However, on 12.01.2019, the private respondents and some police officials came to the house of the petitioner and threatened him not to pursue his application for vacating their illegal possession. He was also threatened by them by saying that his family would

be killed and he would have to face dire consequences. Then the petitioner moved a representation dated 12.01.2019 (Annexure P-9) to respondent No.4-Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda, District Bathinda for protection of life and liberty as the private respondents and police officials are threatening him and his family members. However, no action thereon has been taken by respondent No.4 and the petitioner is continuously receiving threats from the private respondents.

Without commenting on the merits of the case or the veracity of the allegations of the petitioner, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4-Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda, District Bathinda, to look into the representation dated 12.01.2019 (Annexure P-9) and take such action as may be warranted in law.

Disposed of.
