By referring to the status of case viz.-a-viz., the opportunities granted to the plaintiffs to lead evidence, learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the case cannot be kept pending for so long for plaintiffs' evidence and the same needs to be closed by order of the Court.

Though the prayer made in this petition is for issuance of directions to the trial Court to decide the civil suit in a time bound manner, but during course of the arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner confined his prayer only to close evidence of the plaintiffs as they have availed numerous opportunities from 15.12.2015 onwards.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the trial Court to proceed in deciding the suit at the earliest by passing lawful order in respect of closing the evidence of the plaintiffs and thereafter grant reasonable opportunities to the defendant/ petitioner as well.
