Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing the impugned order dated 09.02.2017, passed by learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Shahabad in NACT No.284 of 2016, declaring the petitioner as proclaimed offender along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.
