Vide order dated 30.1.2019, the District Magistrate, Kaithal had been directed to ascertain as to whether the persons, the names of whom are mentioned in para No.2 of the petition, have been illegally detained at the brick kiln in question and to submit a report in this regard.

The learned State counsel has today filed a status report by way of affidavit of Sh. Dharamvir Singh, District Magistrate, Kaithal, wherein it has been deposed that during inspection of the premises in question it was found that the alleged detinue mentioned at serial No.11 namely Karan had already left for his native place. However, another 25 labourers were found alongwith their families. It has been reported that the labourers stated that they had come to the brick kiln through Labour Contractor (Zamadar) Pardeep on 29.12.2018 for work as per their own wishes but since the soil at

the brick kiln was not suitable for them, they were reluctant to work at the brick kiln and expressed their intention to return to their native place. It is reported therein that the labourers had received full wages in respect of the work done by them. It is also stated that the labourers, the names of whom are mentioned in para No.2 of the writ petition, left for their native place alongwith their families in vehicle bearing registration No.HR-67-6720 in the presence of the inspecting team.

In view of the aforesaid report, no further direction is required to be issued. The petition, as such, stands disposed of.
