The present contempt petition is filed for non-compliance of order dated 05.03.2018, vide which, a direction was issued to respondent No.2 to expeditiously conclude the investigation and present the challan in the Court.

Status report by way of affidavit of the respondent filed in Court is taken on record. Copy given to learned counsel for the petitioner. As per the said reply, S.P. Amritsar (Rural) has been directed to monitor investigation of the case and the investigation of the instant case shall be completed and challan shall be presented before the Court. It is further stated that regular departmental inquiry has been initiated against the officer, responsible for non compliance of the order and delaying the investigation.

In view of the same, this Court does not deem it proper to continue with the present contempt petition any further. Accordingly, the same is dismissed.

Rule issued against the respondent stands discharged.

In case the investigation is not completed within another two months, the petitioner is at liberty to revive the present contempt petition.
