Present appeal has been filed against the impugned judgment of conviction and order of sentence dated 19.02.2013 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge-cum-Judge Special Court (NDPS Act), Rupnagar, vide which the appellant was sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for a period of 2 years and to pay fine of Rs. 10,000/- under Section 22(b) of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 and in default of payment of fine to undergo further imprisonment for two months.

It has been pointed out by learned counsel for the appellant that during the pendency of the appeal, the sole appellant -Ranjit Singh died on 16.06.2018 and has produced the death

certificate of the appellant, the same is taken on record.

In view of the above, the present appeal shall stand abated and the same is disposed off as such.

Ordered accordingly.
