Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail in FIR No.136 dated 06.09.2018 under Sections 323, 324, 325, 326, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Chhajli, District Sangrur.

As per allegations in the FIR, registered on the statement of Jagga Singh, his wife Veerpal Kaur was collecting the dried clothes in front of his house, where a scuffle took place, in which the petitioner has caused injuries to the complainant on his face.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody since 12.10.2018 and after registration of the FIR, the matter has been compromised between the parties.

A photocopy of the compromise has been handed over to learned State counsel, who, on instructions from ASI Amrik Singh, has verified the fact

regarding compromise between the parties. It is submitted that challan stands presented and charges have been framed, however, no prosecution witness has been examined so far.

Without commenting anything further on merits of the case, considering the fact that there is a compromise between the parties and the petitioner is in long custody, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing his bail/surety bond to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.

Petition is disposed of.
