**HARINDER SINGH SIDHU J.**

The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking direction to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to provide protection to the lives and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents No. 4 and 5.

It has been averred that the date of birth of petitioner No.1 is 12.11.1996 and date of birth of petitioner No.2 is 28.06.1998 and copies of Matriculation Certificate of both the petitioners to this effect are attached as Annexures P-1 and P-2 respectively.

It has been submitted that the marriage of the petitioners was solemnized on 29.01.2019 according to Sikh rites at Gurudwara at Akalgarh Sahib, Naya Gaon, Mohali. The marriage photographs are attached as Annexure P-3. Private respondents No. 4 and 5 are opposed to the marriage, as the petitioners had performed the marriage without their consent. The petitioners have submitted representation dated 27.01.2019 (Annexure P-4) to respondent No.2 seeking protection of their lives and liberty at the hands of the private respondents.

After hearing counsel for the petitioners and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the validity of the marriage and the age of the petitioners and keeping in view the binding precedent of the Hon'ble Apex Court in *Lata Singh v.State of U.P. And another, 2006(2) SCC (Criminal) 478*, the present petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to look into the said issue and take necessary action in accordance with law.
