This writ petition was filed in the year 1997 seeking a direction to the Municipal Corporation, Chandigarh, to transfer certain named persons from the office of the said Municipal Corporation and from the residence of the Advisor to the Administrator, Union Territory Chandigarh, and the Deputy Commissioner, to various fire stations in Chandigarh, so that their services could be utilized for rendering service to the people of the State.

No interim orders were passed in this writ petition. There is no representation for the petitioner when the matter is taken up for hearing. The cause, as stated supra, would perhaps not survive for consideration at this late stage, 22 years after the filing of the case.

The writ petition is accordingly dismissed for non-prosecution.
