The present petition has been filed by the petitioners under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of a direction to the official respondents No.2 to 4 for protection of their life and liberty at the hands of private respondents No.5 to 9, as they have married against the wishes of private respondents.

Learned State counsel has filed the status report by way of affidavit of Satish Kumar, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Head Quarter, Panipat on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2 and on instructions from ASI Bijender has apprised the Court that the statements of respondents No.5 to 9 have been recorded, wherein they have expressed no objection to

the alleged marriage between the petitioners. He further apprised that the petitioners have produced their separate affidavits dated 22.2.2019, wherein they have also expressed no threat to their married life.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners wishes to withdraw the present petition, as the alleged threat has vanished.

The prayer is accepted.

The petition is allowed to be dismissed as withdrawn.
