1. The present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No.116, dated 21.9.2018, registered at Police Station Sherpur, District Sangrur, under Sections 452, 323, 506, 148, 149 IPC and under Section 3, 4 of SC and ST Act, and proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.
2. Vide order dated 1.2.2019 the parties had been directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court so as to get the statements recorded.
3. Report of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Dhuri, has been received wherein it has been reported that statement of complainant Gurchet Singh, injured Harjit Singh, Gurmail Singh and Major Singh as well as of petitioners/accused Manjot Singh @ Jot and Navpreet

Singh @ Navi, have been recorded to the effect that they have entered into a compromise with the intervention of respectables. The complainant and injured have specifically stated that the matter has been compromised with the petitioners and they do not want to pursue with the matter. Learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Dhuri, opined that the compromise effected between the parties appears to be genuine and effected without any fear or undue influence.

4. In view of the aforesaid report and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the petition is allowed and FIR No.116, dated 21.9.2018, registered at Police Station Sherpur, District Sangrur, under Sections 452, 323, 506, 148, 149 IPC and under Section 3, 4 of SC and ST Act, and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
