Although, prayer in the petition is to release the petitioner on regular bail in FIR NO.149, dated 15.03.2017, registered under Sections 302/34 IPC, at Police Station Assandh, District Karnal, however, learned counsel appearing for the State, at the outset, has submitted that out of 16 witnesses which the prosecution wanted to examine, 14 have already been examined and for remaining 2 witnesses, bailable warrants have been issued for 30.05.2019.
