Reply filed in Court is taken on record subject to just exceptions.

Admittedly, there exists an arbitration clause in the agreement between the parties and this fact is not being disputed by learned counsel appearing for them. It is also not in dispute that disputes and differences have arisen between the parties in respect of the contract and, thus, an independent Arbitrator is to be appointed to settle the disputes.

Accordingly, I hereby appoint Hon'ble Sri Justice C.K. Prasad, a retired Judge of the Supreme Court of India, to act as sole Arbitrator in the matter to resolve the disputes between the parties. The fee, etc. shall be as may be settled by the parties with the learned Arbitrator.
