This petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution for issuance of direction to the respondents to grant four weeks' parole to the petitioner under the provisions of Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1988 for the purpose of attending the marriage of the brother of the petitioner.

The petitioner was convicted and sentenced for life imprisonment vide judgment dated 11.09.2014 passed by learned Sessions Judge, Jhajjar in Case No.50 of 2014 (RBT) under Sections 302 and 449 IPC. Criminal Appeal-D-No.1922-DB of 2014 was filed by the petitioner in which vide judgment dated 30.05.2018, the judgment dated 11.09.2014 was modified and the petitioner was sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for a period of 10 years including remission.

The case of the petitioner is that his brother is getting married on 09.02.2019. He states that after filing of this petition, the marriage of his sister is fixed for 17.02.2019. He has moved an application on 29.01.2019 before respondents No.3 and 4 requesting for his release on parole to attend the marriage of his brother.

The reply has been filed by respondents-State in which the factum of marriage of Gaurav (brother of the petitioner) has been verified.

In view of the aforesaid, this petition is disposed with a direction to respondents No.3 and 4 to take a decision on the application of the petitioner. While doing so, they may take note of the aforesaid fact.
