The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to provide protection to the lives and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents No. 4 to 7.

It has been averred that the date of birth of petitioner No.1 is 19.01.2001 and petitioner No.2 is 08.12.1995. Copies of Aadhar Card and School Certificate qua petitioner No.1 and Aadhar Card and School Leaving Certificate qua petitioner no.2 to this effect are attached as Annexures P-1 (Colly) and P-2 (Colly) respectively.

It has been submitted that the marriage of the petitioners was solemnized on 29.01.2019 at Shri Bhamri Devi Jan Kalyan Sanstha (Regd.) at Mansa Devi Market, Sector 4, Panchkula. The marriage certificate and photographs of the marriage are attached as Annexures P-3 and P-4 respectively. Private respondents No. 4 to 7 are opposed to the marriage, as the petitioners had performed the marriage without their consent. The petitioners have submitted representation dated 29.01.2019 (Annexure P-5) to respondent No.2 seeking protection of their lives and liberty at the hands of the private respondents.

After hearing counsel for the parties and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the validity of the marriage and the age of the petitioners and keeping in view the binding precedent of the Hon'ble Apex Court in *Lata Singh v.State of U.P. And another, 2006(2) SCC (Criminal) 478*, the present petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to look into the matter and take necessary action in accordance with law.
