The petitioner seeks a mandamus directing official respondents No. 2 to 5 to ensure the smooth conduct of the election process of respondent No.6-Society which is otherwise slated for 24.02.2019.

The apprehension voiced in the instant petition is on the basis that the office bearers of respondent No.6-society have in the past also created hurdles as and when the election process was initiated and the Sub Divisional Magistrate, Ludhiana (respondent No.4) had at that point of time intervened and passed order dated 01.04.2015(Annexure P-2).

Counsel submits that a representation has already been submitted before the official respondents and he would be satisfied if directions are issued to them to take necessary precautionary measures.

Without even ascertaining the averments made in the petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the instant writ petition with a direction to respondent No.2 i.e. the Deputy Commissioner, Ludhiana to examine the

matter against the backdrop of the representation dated 25.01.2019 (Annexure P-10) and to thereafter take steps as he may deem fit and as warranted in accordance with law.

Disposed of.
