Gursewak Singh has filed this petition for grant of pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.292 dated 22.11.2018 registered under Sections 420 and 406 of the Indian Penal Code (in short 'IPC') at Police Station Bhawanigarh, District Sangrur.

The FIR was registered on the statement of Ramlubhaya with the allegations that the petitioner was deployed as Driver for tanker No.PB-29-D-9597 by the complainant for delivery/distribution of milk to various places. On 06.11.2018, the petitioner was to deliver 9935 liters of milk from Faguwala Centre to Modern Diary, Karnal. But he delivered only 7990 liters milk and rest of the milk he sold out by way of fraud.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been falsely indicted in the case as the same tanker was driven by another driver. It is further argued that there is a delay of 16 days in lodging the FIR as the occurrence took place on 06.11.2018 and the FIR was recorded on 22.11.2018.

The petitioner is specifically named in the FIR. Considering the specific allegations against the petitioner, no case is made out for grant of extra ordinary concession of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner.

Consequently, petition is dismissed.
