The present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.806 dated 11.12.2018, under Sections 148/149/323/307/506 IPC, registered at Police Station Meham, District Rohtak.

On 04.02.2019, while issuing notice of motion, this Court has passed the following order:-

“Contentends that as per allegations in the FIR, no specific role or injury has been attributed to the petitioner.

Notice of motion for 05.03.2019.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation before the Investigating Officer. In the event of his arrest, the Arresting Officer would admit him to interim bail till the next date of hearing on his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to his satisfaction. The petitioner is also directed to abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C....”

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Harbhaj, stated

that in terms of the order of this Court dated 04.02.2019, the petitioner has

joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no longer required in the present case.

In view of the above, the order dated 04.02.2019 is made absolute. However, it is clarified that the petitioner shall abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed off.
