Present writ petition has been filed seeking the pay scale as granted to the Agriculture Sub Inspectors working in the Soil Conservation and Engineering Department. The petitioners are relying upon the orders passed by this Court in CWP No. 6223 of 2000 in support of the present prayer.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that for the relief which has been claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioners have submitted representations to respondent No.2 on 22.11.2018 and 15.12.2018 (Annexures P-7 and P-8) respectively and the petitioners will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the representations dated 22.11.2018 and 15.12.2018 (Annexures P-7 and P-8) respectively, by passing appropriate speaking order.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that liberty be given to the petitioners to supplement the representations Annexures P-7 and P-8 in case the need arises.

Liberty is granted.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioners for the relief which has been claimed by them in the representations dated 22.11.2018 and 15.12.2018 (Annexures P-7 and P-8) respectively, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the representations dated 22.11.2018 and 15.12.2018 (Annexures P-7 and P-8) respectively or any supplementing representation filed as per liberty granted within a period of three months from the receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case, it is found that the petitioners are entitled to any monetary benefits after the decision of the representations, the same should also be paid to them within three months thereafter.

In case, any further representation is filed by the petitioner supplementing the representations already filed within a period of two weeks from today, the same should also be considered as part of the request on behalf of the petitioners to be considered by the respondents.
