Learned counsel for the respondents submits that writ petition by sheer efflux of time has rendered infructuous.

I am in agreement with the said submission as the record of the writ petition reflects that the petitioner as well as respondent No.11 had joined their services in the year 1972 and 1974 respectively and assuming their age to be 18 years at the time of joining, both would have turned 65 years and 67 years respectively by now and superannuated from their service, during pendency of the writ petition.

Petition is, accordingly, dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.

However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to move an appropriate application, if any, cause of action still survives.
