Petitioner herein seeks issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari to quash the order dated 11.12.1996 (P-4), whereby reservation of post not shown as per policy of reservation.

Perusal of the writ petition reflects that the relief by the petitioner *inter alia* sought at the time of filing of the petition was to quash the order dated 11.12.1996 (P-4) vide which the respondents were stated to have violated the reservation policy applicable in the cadre of Deputy Secretaries while not providing reservation in the Scheduled Castes category. It seems that by sheer efflux of time, the relief sought by the petitioner at this stage is rendered totally infructuous.

In the premise, writ petition is dismissed as infructuous with liberty to the petitioner to file appropriate application, in case any cause of action still survives.
