The present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.194 dated 24.12.2018, under Sections 61-1-14 of Excise Act, registered at Police Station Sadar, Jalandhar.

On 04.02.2019, while issuing notice of motion, this Court has passed the following order:-

“Contends that recovery of the alleged 96 bottles of liquor has already been effected and the petitioner is ready to join the investigation.

Notice of motion for 05.03.2019.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation before the Investigating Officer. In the event of his arrest, the Arresting Officer would admit him to interim bail till the next date of hearing on his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to his satisfaction. The petitioner is also directed to abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C....”

Learned State counsel, on instructions, stated that in terms of

the order of this Court dated 04.02.2019, the petitioner has joined the

investigation and his custodial interrogation is no longer required in the present case.

In view of the above, the order dated 04.02.2019 is made absolute. However, it is clarified that the petitioner shall abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed off.
