GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner seeks quashing of FIR No.19 dated 18.1.2017 under Sections 380, 506 of the Indian Penal Code, Police Station Division No.1, Ludhiana and proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.
2. Vide order dated 4.2.2019 the parties had been directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate so as to get the statements recorded with regard to the genuineness of the compromise.
3. Report of learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ludhiana has been received wherein it has been reported that statements of the

petitioner as well as of complainant-Gurmeet Singh, eye-witnesses Darshan Singh and Jarnail Singh have been recorded who have stated that they have compromised the matter and that complainant & eye-witnesses have have no objection if the FIR is quashed. It has specifically been opined by learned Magistrate that the compromise has been effected between the parties with their free consent and without any inducement or threat of any person.

4. In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the petition is allowed and FIR No.19 dated 18.1.2017 under Sections 380, 506 of the Indian Penal Code, Police Station Division No.1, Ludhiana and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioner.
