This is a revision petition that has been filed seeking to challenge the order of ejectment dated 17.11.2016 passed by the Rent Controller, Khanna which was subsequently affirmed by the Appellate Authority on 20.09.2018 on the ground of *bona fide* personal necessity.

This revision petition was filed in January, 2019 and listed for hearing on 04.02.2019, on which date a request was made for adjournment. The matter was then adjourned to 21.02.2019 and there was no representation on behalf of the petitioner even though the matter had been called twice and in the interest of justice, the case was adjourned to 18.03.2019, on which date there was no representation on behalf of the petitioner and the matter was adjourned to 24.04.2019 since an adjournment slip had been circulated by counsel for the petitioner. On 24.04.2019, the matter was adjourned as the Advocates had abstained from putting in an

appearance and the case was then listed on 13.05.2019, on which date, a request for adjournment by the petitioner through authorized Advocate was circulated and the case was adjourned for today i.e. 19.07.2019. This Court notices that there was no representation on behalf of the petitioner on 13.05.2019 and same is the position today though the matter has been called twice. This Court is of the opinion that the petitioner herein is not interested in contesting the orders of ejectment so passed.

Dismissed for non-prosecution.
