Petitioner is stated to be a Class-I Govt. contractor. It is pleaded that between the years 2011-2013 certain works in the nature of providing and fixing of boundary pillars on the berms of link roads were allotted to the petitioner by respondent no.4 i.e. the Executive Engineer (C) Punjab Mandi Board, Sultanpur Lodhi. The details of the works have been enumerated in para 2 of the writ petition.

The short grievance raised in the instant petition is that inspite of the works having been completed and executed to the satisfaction of the competent authority, an amount of Rs.16,20,866/- is still outstanding.

Counsel would argue that the action of the respondent authorities is arbitrary and the amount has been withheld without any justifiable basis.

Counsel submits that a legal notice dated 10.10.2018 (Annexure P-2) has already been served and he would be satisfied, if, the writ petition was to be disposed of with directions to the concerned/competent authorities to take a final decision thereupon within a stipulated time frame.

Prayer made by counsel is found to be just and reasonable.

Accordingly, without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the instant petition and without going into the merits of the claim, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the same with a direction to respondent no.4 to examine the claim of the petitioner against the backdrop of the legal notice dated 10.10.2018 (Annexure P-2) expeditiously and in any case within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Needless to observe that if any amount is found due to the petitioner, same would be released without any further delay.

Disposed of.
