Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and not to harass them at the instance of respondent Nos.4 & 5.

The petitioners have got married against the wishes of their parents. They are stated to be major. In support of his proof of age petitioner No.1 has placed on record a copy of Fifth Class Examination Certificate (Annexure P-2) wherein his date of birth is mentioned as 05.07.1992 whereas petitioner No.2 has placed on record a copy of Matriculation Examination Certificate (Annexure P-1) depicting her date of birth as 12.09.1995. They have also moved a representation before the

Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar (Annexure P-10) for protection of their life and liberty.

Without adverting to the merits of the controversy and certifying the marriage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2- Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar to take appropriate action on the said representation (Annexure P-10).

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
