Petitioners No. 1 and 2 are the parents and petitioners No. 3 and 4 are sisters of Bikram J.M.Singh who solemnised love marriage against the wishes of their parents with respondent No. 4-Nidhi. Their love marriage could not run smoothly for one reason or the other. Finally, at the behest of her parents, respondent No. 4-Nidhi, leaving the company of her lover-husband, namely Bikram J.M. Singh, started living in her parental home.

According to the petitioners, respondent No. 4 is now harassing them for no reason whatsoever and moving successive applications to the police. Consequently, petitioner No. 2 was picked up from Ferozepur and kept there for two days

in illegal custody. The police officials did not serve any notice under Section 160 Cr.P.C. upon the petitioner before calling her in the police station.

Considering over all facts and circumstances of the case, respondent No. 3- The Commissioner of Police, Panchkula is directed to look into the representation (Annexure P-2), if any, of the petitioner allegedly filed before him in accordance with law and do the needful, if required. Further in case, the petitioners are required by the police, at least one week prior notice under Section 160 Cr.P.C. be served upon the petitioners.

The instant petition stands disposed of, accordingly.
