Petitioner herein seeks issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari to quash the order dated 01.07.1996 (Annexure P-10), whereby the claim of the petitioner for grant of pension has been rejected.

On a query posed by the Court, learned counsel for the petitioner concedes that despite her attempts she is not able to contact the petitioner. Even a letter written to the petitioner has not been responded to and therefore, she is not aware whereabouts of the petitioner.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, it seems that by sheer efflux of time, the relief sought by the petitioner would have been rendered infructuous as she would currently be around 72 years old and must have lost the interest in this petition.

Writ petition is dismissed as infructuous with liberty to the petitioner to file appropriate application, in case any cause of action still survives.
