The petitioner has filed present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of a directions to the official respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 6.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that for the aforesaid relief, the petitioner has already made a representation dated 20.12.2018 (Annexure P-1) to respondent No.2 Superintendent of Police, Sirsa and at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the respondent No.2 to consider the said representation regarding protection of her life and liberty only at the hands of private respondents.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only at this stage.

On asking of this Court, Ms. Mahima Yashpal, A.A.G., Haryana accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and perusing the representation (Annexure P-1), it emerges that the petitioner has dispute with her husband/in-laws and for this reason, she has left her matrimonial home and now staying with some Manoj Godara resident of Section 20, Part II, HUDA, Sirsa to whom she knew previously. However, without making any observation on the merits of the case and considering the fact that the petitioner has confined her prayer qua protection of her “life and liberty only”, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the contents of representation (Annexure P-1) qua protection of “life and liberty only” of the petitioner at the hands of private respondents and to act in accordance with law.
