for directing the respondents to take action against the private respondents

After arguing for sometime, it has been agreed by the counsel
for the petitioner and the counsel for respondents No.6 and 7 that it would
be appropriate if the application under Order 39 Rule 2 (A) CPC moved by
the petitioner is decided expeditiously.

I find this to be a fair submission. In the circumstances, this
petition is disposed of with a direction to the trial Court to decide the case
by 15.07.2019 after giving two opportunities to each of the parties to lead

their entire evidence on their own responsibility.
