Present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short 'Cr.P.C') for grant of bail pending trial to the petitioner in case FIR No. 95 dated 03.11.2017 under Section 302/34 Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short 'IPC') and Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station MDC Panchkula (Haryana).

Learned counsel for the petitioner confines his prayer, at this stage, only for grant of interim bail to the petitioner for three days on account of marriage of his cousin sister namely, Karampreet Kaur on 18.02.2019.

Learned State counsel has also acknowledged that there is no other criminal case pending against the petitioner.

The factum of marriage of Kamalpreet Kaur is duly acknowledged by learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Suraj Mal and the same is not disputed by learned counsel for the complainant as well. The only apprehension expressed by learned counsel for the complainant is that if the petitioner is released on bail, there is every possibility that he will abscond and it would be very difficult to secure his presence and that will hamper the trial. Therefore, some police official may be deputed along with him so that he may not run away.

Heard both sides.

Since the marriage of the cousin sister of the petitioner is duly

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acknowledged by both sides and the apprehension of the learned counsel for the complainant seems to be justified. Thus, petitioner is ordered to be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of learned CJM/Duty Magistrate concerned with heavy surety from 17.02.2019 to 19.02.2019. It is directed that petitioner shall remain in company of two police officials, to be deputed by Deputy Commissioner of Police, concerned and they will be responsible to produce him back. Expenses shall be borne and deposited by the petitioner, as per rules. Petitioner shall surrender before the Jail Authorities on 20.02.2019 at 10:00 am sharp.

Disposed off accordingly.
