Issue raised in the instant petition is with regard to allotment of chambers to advocates in the Tehsil Compound Panipat.

Case of the petitioner is that while making allotments no transparent procedure has been followed and neither have any rules been framed that would regulate and determine such allotment.

The instant petition is completely lacking in terms of necessary averments/material as regards the extent of control exercised by the district administration on the allotment of chambers. It is not even discernible as to whether such allotment has been made at the hands of the concerned Bar Association.

In the absence of relevant records/averments, prayer of the petitioner cannot be gone into and examined.

Dismissed.
