1. In view of the orders passed in letters patent appeal, the delay of 237 days in filing the review application is condoned.

2. Notice of the review application.

3. Ms. Shruti Jain Goyal, DAG, Haryana accepts notice.

4. Heard for disposal.

5. It is clarified that the words “no worth” in the order under review are limited to the context of petitioners therein seeking public employment in the State of Haryana in a service matter and these words are to be read confined to the text and context of the case decided and the petition dismissed. The State of Haryana does not recognize certificates, degrees and diplomas awarded by the Para Medical Council, Punjab, Mohali.

6. The Court has been informed of the pendency of the Special Leave Petition in which leave has been granted by the Supreme Court in an appeal by the Para Medical Council, Punjab, Mohali arising out of the order passed by the Division Bench of this Court in LPA No.891 of 2011 in case titled *Para Medical Council, Mohali vs State of Haryana and others* decided on May 20, 2011. The interim orders of Supreme Court have been produced and perused. There is a stay of criminal prosecution against the members of the Council but I do not find that the operation of the orders of Division Bench have been stayed. Obviously, as far as the Para Medical Council, Punjab-applicant for review of the order dated May 15, 2018 is concerned the words “no worth” shall remain subject to outcome of the Special Leave Petition (Civil) converted on leave granted to Civil Appeal No.16755 of 2011 and two connected appeals i.e. CA 29168 of 2011 and CA 8285 of 2013 (all filed by Para Medical Council, Punjab, Mohali) regarding the legal status of the Council. However, as far as the petitioner Manoj Kumar and others are concerned, they will remain governed by the order dated May 15, 2018.

7. Accordingly, the review application stands disposed of.
