The present petition has been filed by the petitioners under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of a direction to the official respondents No.1 to 3 for protection of their life and liberty at the hands of private respondents No.4 and 5, as they have performed marriage on 31.01.2019 against the wishes of private respondents.

Learned State counsel has apprised the Court that the statement of petitioners dated 18.02.2019 have been recorded, wherein they have expressed no threat to their married life and statement of Prince (respondent No.5) dated 19.02.2019 has also been recorded, wherein he expressed that he has no relation with her sister as she has performed marriage at her own will. The copies of the statements have been produced.

No one has put in appearance on behalf of learned counsel for

the petitioners. Same was the position on the last two consecutive dates of hearing. It appears that the petitioners are not interested in pursuing their petition.

In view of the above, nothing survives for adjudication in the present petition.
