The present writ petition was admitted in the year 1998. Record of the case reflects that the petitioners joined the services of respondent No.4-Municipal Corporation sometime in the years 1963 to 1991. By rough estimate, currently the age of some of the petitioners would be more than 75 years and/or some of them may not be interested in their cause by sheer efflux of time. The nature of relief sought by them seems to have been rendered infructuous.
