The instant petition is for quashing of FIR No. 72, dated 11.05.2016, under Sections 452, 323, 324, 341, 506, 427, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Daba, District Ludhiana and the consequent proceedings arising out of the same, on the basis of written compromise deed dated 19th January, 2019 (Annexure P-1) arrived at between the parties.

Report has been received from the Ld. JMIC, Ludhiana after statements of the parties were recorded regarding the compromise. As per the report the compromise is voluntary and without any pressure or coercion. The trial Court has also sent copy of the statements of parties and the compromise.

Learned State counsel submits that petitioners are the only accused persons and respondent No.2 is the only aggrieved person in this FIR.

In view of the statements and report of the Ld. JMIC, Ludhiana and the principles laid down by the Full Bench judgment of this Court in **Kulwinder**

Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another, 2007(3) RCR (Criminal)

others (2012) 10 SCC 303, the instant petition is allowed and the aforesaid FIR and all consequent proceedings conducted on the basis thereof are quashed qua the petitioners.

Needless to say that parties shall remain bound by the terms of compromise and their statements made in the Court below.
