Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that although FIR No.123 dated 10.04.2018 under Sections 323, 451, 506, 427, 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, Police Station Division No.1, Ludhiana was lodged at the instance of the petitioner in April, 2018 but no effective investigation had been conducted in the matter so far.
2. Having heard, learned counsel for the petitioner, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana to look into the matter and to dispose of representation (Annexure P-7) expeditiously and to ensure that the

matter is investigated and a final report is filed at the earliest.
