The learned counsel contends that the private respondents had caused as many as five injuries to the petitioner No.1 Gurmeet Singh as would be evident from the MLR (Annexure P-1) on 10.1.2019 but despite the fact that a complaint (Annexure P-3) was made to the police, no action has been taken thereupon.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioners, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, District Amritsar Rural to look into the matter and to dispose of the representation dated 16.1.2019 (Annexure P-4) (although addressed to D.G.P., Punjab Police, Chandigarh) expeditiously in accordance with law. In case the allegations levelled therein are found to be well founded then necessary steps be taken thereupon as warranted under law.

A copy of this order alongwith representation dated 16.1.2019 (Annexure P-4) be sent to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, District Amritsar Rural so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
