Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.0001 dated 03.01.2019 under Sections 324, 323, 295, 452, 148, 149 IPC (Section 325 IPC was added later on), registered at Police Station Gidderbaha, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

While granting interim bail to the petitioners, following order was passed on 01.03.2019: -

“Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that as per allegations in the FIR and the corresponding injuries in the MLR, the grievous injury is attributed to non-applicants/co-accused Harmeet Singh and Gurmeet Singh, whereas the injuries attributed to the petitioners are only falling under Section 323 IPC. It is further submitted that petitioner No.2 is aged about 63 years and the FIR is registered on account of a dispute arising out of Panchayat elections.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Roshan Lal

and assisted by learned counsel for the complainant, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioners be directed to join the investigation.”

The Investigating Officer, who is present in the Court, has submitted that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, the petitioners have joined the investigation and are no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 01.03.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
